

The arrival from the airport to the Le Meridien Vienna

There are 3 modes of transportation available when travelling from Vienna International airport (VIE) to the city centre of Vienna: **Taxi**, **Train** and **Bus**. Hiring a Vienna airport **taxi** will cost approximately 36 € and it will take about 20 minutes to the hotel.

Train

When it comes to travelling by **train**, travellers have 2 options. You can either take the City Airport Train (CAT) or the public Schnellbahn S7. One-way ticket costs EUR 11,00 / return EUR 19,00 and the ride takes 16 minutes to Landstraße (U-Bahn/metro line U4), whereas tickets for the public S7 cost only EUR 4,20 and the average travel time is 25 minutes. Stops are Landstraße (U4) ore Praterstern (U1 or U2). [More information](#)

Bus

Buses can also provide cheap and fast services. Bus tickets cost only 8 € (single) and 13 € (return) and the journey takes about 20 minutes. Stops are Hauptbahnhof (U-Bahn/metro line U1). [More information](#)

Afterwards you need to take the **metro** line U1, U2 or U2 until the station Karlsplatz. From there it is only 3 to 5 minutes by walk to the Le Meridien.

Taxi

You can also take a regular taxi: there are some taxi desks on the departure exit of the airport, which are offering you the transportation around 37-50 Euros (the price is not always fix!) You can also take the airport taxi, there are different providers:

The limousine services of the hotel: the service costs EUR 58,00 from the airport to Le Meridien Vienna hotel. From the hotel to the airport it costs EUR 48,00
